

Royal Wedding at Windsor Castle

Prince Harry and Meghan Markle are to marry at St George's Chapel. The 15th century building shielded by the walls of Windsor Castle has hosted several royal weddings and is the final resting place of 10 monarchs

9.30am - 11am

4:30am to 6am- EST - USA

Guests congregate at the Round Tower and enter the chapel through the South Door before taking their seats

11.20am

6:20am- EST - USA

Members of the Royal family arrive and enter via the Galilee Porch

11.45am

6:45am- EST

Prince Harry and the Duke of Cambridge arrive at the Chapel's West Steps. They are expected to walk past the thousands of spectators invited into the castle's grounds. Prince Harry will have the chance to acknowledge the 200 representatives from charities he is associated with gathered in the Horseshoe Cloister

11.55am

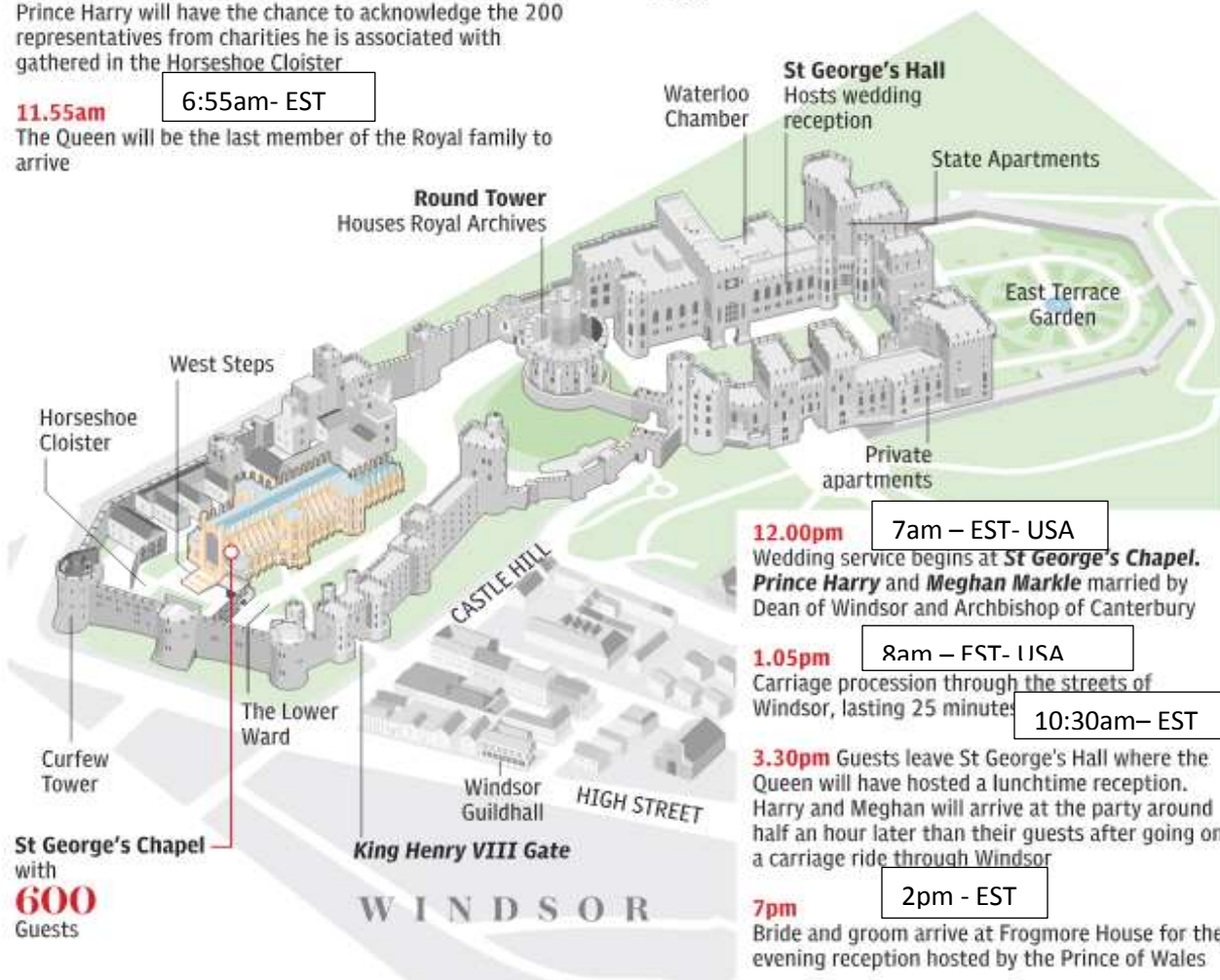
6:55am- EST

The Queen will be the last member of the Royal family to arrive

6:59am - EST

11.59am

Meghan Markle arrives at the Chapel's West Steps by car with her bridesmaids and pageboys. The car will take Ms Markle and her mother Doria Ragland past some of the crowds in the Long Walk. When the car stops at the castle her mother will get out and the bridesmaids and pageboys climb in. Ms Ragland will enter the chapel by the Galilee Porch Ms Markle's father Thomas Markle will have arrived at the same entrance and make his way to the West Door where he will meet his daughter before the ceremony begins



12.00pm

7am - EST- USA

Wedding service begins at **St George's Chapel**. **Prince Harry** and **Meghan Markle** married by Dean of Windsor and Archbishop of Canterbury

1.05pm

8am - FST- USA

Carriage procession through the streets of Windsor, lasting 25 minutes

10:30am- EST

3.30pm

Guests leave St George's Hall where the Queen will have hosted a lunchtime reception. Harry and Meghan will arrive at the party around half an hour later than their guests after going on a carriage ride through Windsor

7pm

2pm - EST

Bride and groom arrive at Frogmore House for the evening reception hosted by the Prince of Wales

600 Guests in the St. George's Chapel at Windsor Castle

On the Castle Grounds -200 Charity Representatives, 1200 members of the public, 1400 Palace staff, 100 local school children
